DISCRIMINATION: CHOOSING TO SEE THE DIFFERENCE

A Lesson in Perception versus Truth

I once went on a rafting trip. Waste disposal was a problem. A phrase I heard a lot was "Dilution is the Solution to Pollution." I think they were saying you could pee in the river water (among other things) and not worry about it.

The idea is that if you mix a little bit of waste with a whole lot of clean (water), you won't notice the waste...or the waste will have no consequence. We've all heard of the number of bug parts per million that are permitted in our food supply, so I guess that idea has caught on. And our environments are now heavily polluted. Over time, our tolerance for pollution has grown. We keep moving the standard. Actually, 'standard' is the wrong word to use. Standards are absolute, unchanging. A movable standard isn't a standard...it's an oxymoron. So we live in an age of deceit: pollution is acceptable to an ever-increasing level, and standards...aren't. Worse, we seem to think that if we see things that way, God must see them that way as well.

He doesn't.

And this is the message that we have heard from Him, and announce to you, that God is light, and darkness in Him is not at all; if we may say—'we have fellowship with Him,' and in the darkness may walk—we lie, and do not the truth;

A stone and a stone, an ephah and an ephah, both are hateful to Jehovah. (LITV)

A stone and a stone, an ephah and an ephah, Even both of them are an abomination to Jehovah. (YLT)

Two stones when there should be just one stone; two measures when there should be just one measure.

Both really similar, but enough difference to give an unfair advantage.

One is TRUE, the other is FALSE. FALSE...not 'almost true'.

Speaking of stones:

When you throw a rock into a pond, you'll see a series of rings going out from where it hit.

The ring takes on the shape of the rock.

If it is a round rock, the rings will be circular

If a square rock, the rings will be square. Initially...

Some people think the rings are all circular.

A little bit of reflection shows this can't be, though:

Can a casting take on any shape except the mold which made it?


Must not a shadow take on the shape of that which cast it?

Or so it appears....



There are lots of ways to look at things: up close, or from a distance.


You can decide how you want to look at them.

You can decide what you want to focus on.

Some people don't want to discriminate or discern, because they know there are consequences.


So they back up until everything looks the same. Like this:

Zoom out: lose detail



Maybe that's not far enough?

Zoom out more: just a dot



Ah, that's more comfortable!

Now they look exactly the same!

Get far enough away, and everything becomes 'one'. Delusions are for those who prefer lies.

Sight is for those with courage, who choose the responsibility of truth.


There are those who aren't satisfied with appearances.

They want the truth, even when it condemns themselves...


So they move in for a closer look:

Zoom in: gain detail




Things are beginning to look a little different now.

The left side rings:




The smallest ring:




The left side is concentric circles.

What about the right side?

The right side: Not rings!



The right side: a rectangle!



Some people will have noticed right off that something was not quite right.

That there was just a miniscule straight section on four 'sides'.

Some people will see that, and ignore those straight sides, focusing instead on the curves.

After all, the radius of each curve corresponds exactly to the radius of the respective circle on the left...close enough, right? "Hey, let's ignore our differences and focus on our commonalities!"

"We can just agree to disagree!"

That's much more comfortable!

Or so we've been taught.

But does that really sound like God to you?

That's God's standard: Himself!

Is it okay to be 'just a little bit different' than God?

Just a little bit 'imperfect'?

And Abram is a son of ninety and nine years, and Jehovah appeareth unto Abram, and saith unto him, 'I *am* God Almighty, walk habitually before Me, and be thou perfect; and I give My covenant between Me and thee, and multiply thee very exceedingly.'

Genesis 17:1-2

Do you want to argue what 'perfect' means?

WHY? What MOTIVE?

Perfect:

H8549 תַּתִים tâmîym taw-meem'

From H8552; entire (literally, figuratively or morally); also (as noun) integrity, truth: without blemish, complete, full, perfect, sincerely (-ity), sound, without spot, undefiled, upright (-ly), whole. Be not led astray, my brethren beloved; every good giving, and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the lights, with whom is no variation, or shadow of turning;

James 1:16-17

Are these the same? NO.

Outwardly, they 'might' look the 'same'.

But God looks deep inside...at the heart...to the source.

What 'spirit' created those ripples? His? Or a stranger's?

So about that pollution.

You can keep offsetting those shapes outward, until eventually they become *virtually* identical.

You can 'dilute' the 'pollution' of the straight sides with the curves.

But that will never change the fact that the sources are completely different.

They are not 'one'.

The are utterly distinct.

A thought to ponder:

The best counterfeit is the one which is most like the original...yet isn't.

The 'polluted' parts are so small, they become 'diluted' into obscurity. But they are still counterfeits.

In fact, the worst kind of counterfeits: they are most likely to be accepted as the genuine.

The difference between the real and the fake is not what they look like. Looks are deceiving:

Who hath given credence to that which we heard? And the arm of Jehovah, On whom hath it been revealed? Yea, he cometh up as a tender plant before Him, And as a root out of a dry land, He hath no form, nor honour, when we observe him, nor appearance, when we desire him. He is despised, and left of men, A man of pains, and acquainted with sickness, And as one hiding the face from us, He is despised, and we esteemed him not.

(lsa 53:1-3)

The difference is the source.

So what kind of person are you?

Do you close your eyes to the differences because you dislike the discomfort?

Do you back away from the truth until the discrepancies between you and the standard becomes tolerable? Are you okay with 'just a little bit' of pollution, so long as it is highly diluted?

Maybe a fly in the ointment isn't such a bad thing after all, so long as there is a lot of ointment?

Thought exercise:

Find a dogpile in the grass on the street; collect a teaspoon full of it.

Buy a fifty gallon drum of chocolate peanut butter; mix them up together, blend them up real nice.

Spread it on your bread, and eat it.

Good idea?

If you find that revolting:

Isn't that exactly what you are doing in all the other, more important areas of your life?

Like your 'religion', your 'entertainment', your 'education'?

Where do you go for your knowledge?

Two trees in the garden of Eden.

From which tree do you habitually eat?

PROFANE UNCLEAN DARKNESS LIE **EVIL IMPERFECT TREE OF KNOWLEDGE** When a person ought to understand a spiritual reality from their physical surrounds, and yet fails to take a lesson from it,

Jesus calls it 'hypocrisy.'

How much dilution of poop to peanut butter are you okay with? One part in a million?

And if you rightly turn away the contaminated *food*, why do you not the same with something much more important: what you put into your head, and heart?

...and then shall be revealed the Lawless One, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the manifestation of his presence, him, whose presence is according to the working of the Adversary, in all power, and signs, and lying wonders, and in all deceitfulness of the unrighteousness in those perishing, because the love of the truth they did not receive for their being saved, and because of this shall God send to them a working of delusion, for their believing the lie, that they may be judged—all who did not believe the truth, but were well pleased in the unrighteousness. 2 Thessalonians 2:8-12 (YLT)

Is a *little bit* of the lie is okay to you, so long as it is watered down with the 'truth'?

Is the *unadulterated* truth a little too uncomfortable for you?

Are *you* a candidate for deception given by God in judgment for that attitude?

You will NEVER learn the Truth by studying the LIE.

You will ONLY learn the Truth from the Truth.

Simon Peter, therefore, answered him, 'Sir, unto whom shall we go? thou hast sayings of life age-during; and we have believed, and we have known, that thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.' (John 6:68-69) Time is running out to change your choices!

The truth is not a game, not a perception.

It is an absolute, an unchanging standard, unpolluted, undiluted.

Do you love it, or do you hate it?

And now, O ye priests, this commandment is for you. If ye will not hear, and if ye will not lay it to heart, to give glory unto my name, saith the LORD of hosts, I will even send a curse upon you, and I will

curse your blessings: yea, I have cursed them already, because ye do not lay it to heart. Behold, I will corrupt your seed, and spread dung upon your faces, even the dung of your solemn feasts; and one shall take you away with it.

Malachi 2:1-3

And ye shall know that I have sent this commandment unto you, that my covenant might be with Levi, saith the LORD of hosts. My covenant was with him of life and peace; and I gave them to him for the fear wherewith he feared me, and was afraid before my name. Do you want the truth regardless of cost?

Or do you prefer a delusion?

It is high time to grow up and judge righteously.

It is high time to exercise discretion, discriminating between 'spirit' and Spirit.

It is time for faces of flint, which choose to see.
